


% Total Citations 2021 Annual Program Review




% Total AFIs January 2021 Annual Program Review




Program/Complement History: Neurological Surgery




Program/Complement History: ESN

January-April 2022 RC Meetings

Changes in Participating Sites

- The request must be initiated through ADS
- If site is not available in the drop-down list, contact your Institutional Coordinator to add site.
- RC staff will contact program for additional information; Guidelines are available on [RC webpage](#)

Residents must not rotate to the proposed site until the request has been approved.



International Rotations

International Rotation Application Process

- Must be offered as electives only
- Must receive prior approval of the American Board of Neurological Surgery (ABNS)
- No cases may be entered into the ACGME Case Log System
- Submit to the RC 6-9 months before start date
- Send request to cmeza@acgme.org



Changes in Resident Complement

- Requests for Complement Increase must be submitted through ADS and have DIO approval
 - ✓ Educational Rationale
 - ✓ Major changes in the program since last review
 - ✓ Response to previous citations
 - ✓ Current/Proposed Block diagrams
 - ✓ Institutional Operative Data for the recent academic year
- Programs over complement for 90 days or less do NOT require RC approval
- Permanent and Temporary Increases are reviewed at scheduled RC meetings only; be mindful of agenda closing dates.




CASE LOG UPDATE



Graduating Residents Below Minimum




Program Compliance 2017-2021





Upcoming NS Changes



In June 2020, the Board approved formation of a special task force to examine the principles that should guide creation of requirements that quantify the effort required to administer the educational program of residents and fellows.



In June 2021, the ACGME Board approved focused revisions to Section II of the Common Program Requirements related to dedicated time for program directors, assistant/associate program directors, program coordinators, and core faculty members.



Review Committees to review existing specialty- and subspecialty-specific requirements and determine whether existing requirements fall within the range of options provided by the guidelines.

If requirement changes needed related to dedicated time for program leadership and/or program coordinator, focused revision is required.



NS-RRC Recommendations

PD/APD/Core Faculty

The Committee recommended Four Tiers along with some dedicated time for Core Faculty:

- Tier 1: up to 7 trainees - 20% FTE (PD)
- Tier 2: 8-14 trainees - 20% FTE (PD)/10% FTE (APD)
- Tier 3: 15-20 trainees - 20% FTE (PD)/15% FTE (APD)
- Tier 4: 21+ trainees - 20% FTE (PD)/20%FTE (APD)
- Core Faculty: 5% FTE (Program size does not matter)

Note: the tiers are based on total resident complement not the number of trainees in a single year.



NS-RRC Recommendations

Program Coordinator

The Committee recommended Four Tiers for Program Coordinators:

- Tier 1: up to 7 trainees – 50% FTE
 - Tier 2: 8-14 trainees – 70% FTE
 - Tier 3: 15-20 trainees – 80% FTE
 - Tier 4: 21+ trainees – 100% FTE
- We recognize that program coordinators may be given additional responsibilities that are not within the purview of the ACGME.
 - We encourage programs to focus on allocating time between ACGME-required program administration and other duties required by the institution, so that these individuals are not overburdened.

Note: the tiers are based on total resident complement not the number of trainees in a single year.
